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## What is Home Health Care?

Home health care is a broad spectrum of professional and technical services delivered in the home. Home care is appropriate whenever a person needs assistance that cannot be easily provided by family members or friends. Home health care ideally helps the homebound person receive the care they need for recovery within the home setting. Home health care provides skilled services on an intermittent basis under the supervision of the physician.

## Home Health Care Advantages

- Shorter recovery time - patients often recover more quickly at home.
- Greater privacy - you will feel more in control and at ease in the familiar surroundings of your own home while being near family and friends.
- Seamless access to other post-acute care services.

- Early hospital discharge.
- Lower healthcare costs - often lower than inpatient care in a hospital or permanent institutional placement.
- Prevention of acute inpatient admission.

## Requesting Services

Anyone can request home health care for a person who is unable to take care of his or her own care needs. A patient does not have to be hospitalized to receive home health care. All patients have the right to choose and select the home health care agency of their choice. Hospitals are governed by laws that protect the patient's right to choose their own home health agency, that is, provided the agency is a qualified home care agency and is approved to provide home health care services in the patient's county of residence. Hospitals must provide a listing of qualified home care agencies to patients in need of home care services prior to discharge from the hospital. Patients can request Home Health Plus, Inc. as their home care agency at any time during their hospitalization. All services are coordinated between our home health professionals and the physician. A physician's order is required for our service to be provided. We can help evaluate what services might be covered for your circumstances.
